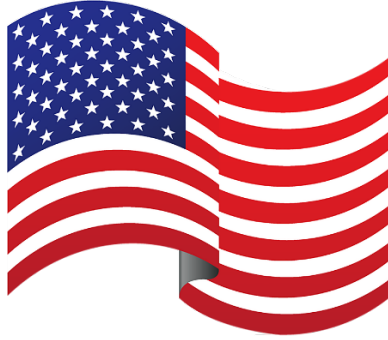

TWO ST. PETER'S SCHOLARSHIP OFFERED
