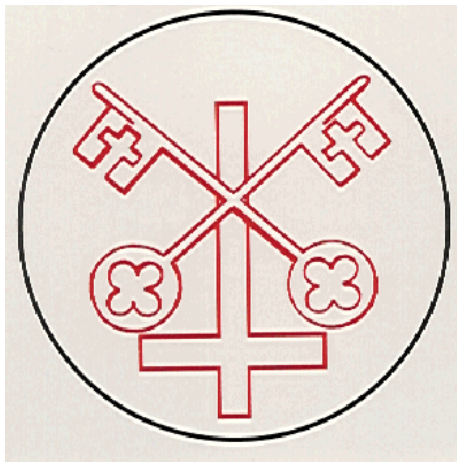

TWO ST.PETER'S SCHOLARSHIP OFFERED

Applications are invited from students, who have graduated this year from senior high school, for two St. Peters Scholarships of \$1,500.00 each, tenable at any accredited United States College. The completed application form with a high school transcript, two reference letters (one academic and the other non-academic), a copy of a letter of acceptance from an accredited college, and a 400-word essay on the applicants' career goals.
