Please read your Bible and other materials such as Forward Day by Day, 2018 Lenten Meditations, attend one of the Services on Tuesday evening or Wednesday morning, and stay for Bible Study. Note that fasting should be undertaken only if health will permit. Lenten folders are available at the back of the church for special offerings.
